Here you will have the opportunity of swimming in the crystal-blue waters of Orak Island and enjoying lunch, we will then sail to Cokertme, a small and picturesque fishing town, for dinner and an overnight stay. If the weather conditions permit, it may be possible to use the sail on the way. Guests are welcome to take a short walk on the shore.


Day 3: SEVEN ISLANDS (KUFRE / UZUN LIMAN -LONG PORT) - ENGLISH HARBOUR

Before breakfast in the early morning, we will cruise to Seven Islands. You will experience another excellent day in the Seven Islands Region. In this region which is full of many small islands and coral reef; it is recommended that you should dive, swim, sleep and rest. Our guests can also enjoy a walk in the forests which are filled with pine trees. Our first stop in Seven Islands Region will be Kufre Bay. Then we will be anchoring at Uzun Liman (Long Port). Afterwards we will cruise to English Port for dinner and an overnight stay. The name English Port comes from the time of 2nd World War as the ships of British Navy forces used to dock here. In this area, there are so many small and large bays which are suitable and sheltered enough to anchor for the boats.

Day 4: CLEOPATRA ISLAND - KARACASOGUT

We will cruise to Sedir (Cedrae) Island. This unique island with its small beach and unbelievable clear water is like an open-air museum. Then our boat will sail to Karacasogut village for dinner and spend the night there. This lovely village is located at 25 km away from Marmaris. Therefore, it is possible to visit Marmaris via 'dolmus' (mini buses) if you want. We also have an optional tour to Dalyan - Caunos

Day 5: LONGOZ - TUZLA

Morning swimming will soon become a part of your daily activities. For lunch, our captain will cruise to Longoz Bay; another place which is like paradise, sheltered with huge pine forests. After lunch, you can enjoy a short walk in the forest and take a rest in Ali Baba's local shed-like cafe. Afterwards the gulet will be anchoring at Tuzla Bay to enjoy a swimming break in the turquoise-blue waters. Dinner and overnight stay at Tuzla.

Day 6: KARGILI - KISEBUKU (ALAKISLA BUKU)

We will be in Kargili Bay (Molla Ibrahim Bay) early in the morning. After lunch, we will be anchoring at Kisebuku (Alakisla Buku). Here you can see the ruins of Byzantines. We will spend the night in this lovely bay.

We will sail to Pabucburnu after breakfast and enjoy lunch here. Tea will be served in Yaliciftlik Bay. An optional village tour can be arranged from this bay for those who are wishing to experience the local life. Bedri Rahmi is a famous Turkish artist who made one of the first 'Blue Cruises' in Turkey. Following his visit the bay was named after him.





Day 2: CNIDUS - INCEBURUN - KARGI BAY


We will depart after the breakfast for Cnidus. Lunch will be served at the bay of Cnidus. Then we will cruise to Inceburun. Here the water is superb and you again will have the opportunity to swim in these crystal waters. Today, our last stop will be at Kargi bay.

Day 3: DIRSEKBUKU - KIZIL ADA - BOZBURUN


The breakfast will be served at Dirsekbuku, we will cruise and anchor at Kizil Ada for lunch and a swimming break. Today, our last stop will be at Bozburun. Bozburun is a small fishing town. This area was popular and suitable for sponge-diving but nowadays the people of the island are no longer interested in sponge-diving as it is not financially beneficial and is dangerous. In the recent years sponge-diving has been replaced by gulet tourism.

Day 4: RHODES

We will cruise to Rhodes early in the morning. Here you can join our optional old city tour. The main port of Rhodes is Rhodes City which bears the same name as the island. The other touristical areas of Rhodes island are; Lindos and Kamiros. Here there will be another optional exursion; Lindos Tour. This city, which is still surrounded by a 12 meter thick city-wall which gives you the feeling of travelling back to Medieval times especially when you walk around its narrow, stone-paved roads. After dinner, we highly recommend you to enjoy in Rhodes Town night out.







Day 5: SYMl

We will set sail to Symi Island and anchor at a near bay to Symi Harbour for lunch and a swimming break. We will anchor at Symi Port late in the afternoon. You can see the shoreline with its neo-classical houses and the peripheral districts. You are going to adore Symi Island for its pine and oak forests and unique bays.

Day 6: NISYROS - COS (KOS)

Early in the morning we will cruise to Nisyros Island and will have a swimming break. You can take an optional bus tour to the crater (volcano) which is still active and you will see the gases coming from underground. Then we will cruise to Kos Island. You may take a quick swim in Lambi Beach which is very close to Kos Harbour. Kos is one of the islands with the best night life. Nafklirou, a street full of bars, is always crowded, colourful, and full of life.

Day 7: BLACK ISLAND (POYRAZ HARBOUR - METEOR BAY) – BODRUM

We will cruise to Bodrum for the customs formalities. Afterwards swimming break will take place and lunch will be served at Poyraz Bay which is located on the northern side of Karaada (Black Island). This is such a nice bay with its turquoise-blue waters. We will be anchoring at Meteor Bay for tea time which is located on the southern side of the island. There is a meteor hole here and this is how the bay got its name. Here you may jump over the platform into the deep water. You may also take a walk through the underwater caves which are very near to Meteor Bay for a small local fee. We will dock in Bodrum Harbour for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 4: PATMOS

We will cruise to Patmos Island early in the morning. We will have a swimming break in a bay around the island. Patmos is not a big island, but it is one of the best known. It was here that St. John completed the last part of 'The Apocalypse of John', and this is why Patmos is sometimes called "The Jerusalem of the Aegean". The Monastery of St. John's towers above the capital, a village called Chora, and actually the whole island breathes of faith and devotion. According to mythology, Patmos was a present from Zeus to his daughter Artemis, goddess of hunting and young women. She was worshipped here in antiquity, and the monastery of St. John was built on her temple. You may have an optional tour to these places. After breakfast, you may have a walk through the monasteries. Our yacht will stay in Patmos Port for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 1: BODRUM

Boarding starts at 15:30 from Bodrum Harbour. On the first day, our boat will remain anchored in Bodrum Port for dinner and an overnight stay. Bodrum has a history that goes back to the 12th century B.C. The city which was called 'Halicarnassus' was the birthplace of Herodotus; the 'Father of History' who lived in the 5th century B.C. The 'Mausoleum' of King Mausolus (350 B.C.) one of the Seven Wonders of the World is in this city. The only structure that survived from the Classical Era is the Amphitheatre. Another place that you should visit when you arrive in Bodrum is the landmark of the city, the 'Castle of Saint Peter'. It is one of the best preserved pieces of architecture with a history dating back to the Middle Ages.


Day 2: PALAMUTBUKU - INCEBURUN

After breakfast, you will be informed about the cruise itinerary and the boat. Then we will start to cruise to Palamutbuku Bay early in the morning. We will anchor at Ince Burun after lunch and swimming breaks. We will stay in this lovely bay for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 3: AKTUR - BENCIK

After breakfast we will cruise to Aktur Bay. Then we will anchor at Bencik Bay; which has a very narrow entrance but a unique view once you get inside. Bencik is located at the narrowest part of the peninsula that divides Hisaronu Gulf from the Gokova Gulf but it is located at Hisaronu side. In 550s B.C. the Cnidus people wanted to dig a tunnel in the narrowest land piece of the peninsula between the Hisaronu Gulf and the Gokova Gulf as a defence line against the Persians. They started with diligence and put in a lot of effort; however, in the end they could not manage and the city was conquered by the Persians. Dinner and an overnight stay will be in Bencik Bay.







Day 4: EMEL SAYIN - ORHANİYE - SELİMİYE

After breakfast, we will anchor in Emel Sayın Bay and you can enjoy a swimming stop in this lovely bay. For lunch we will dock in Orhaniye. In Orhaniye Bay, you will see the unique scenery of a natural tidal formation called 'Kız Kumu' (Maiden's Beach). There are so many myths about this reddish sand-path going from the shore to the inner parts of the sea which is suitable for walking along. On a tiny island located in the bay, you can see the wrecks of an antique castle, a sign of an ancient city. Today, our final destination will be Selimiye for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 5: DIRSEKBUKU - BOZBURUN

After anchoring in Dirsekbuku, we will go to Bozburun which is a small fishing town. This area was popular and suitable for sponge-diving but nowadays the people of the island are no more interested in sponge-diving as it is not financially beneficial and is dangerous. In recent years sponge-diving has been replaced by gulet tourism and nowadays Bozburun Gulets take their place in this sector.

Day 6: DATÇA - KNIDOS (CNIDUS)

We will cruise to Datca. Food and water will be supplied to the boat from Datca Harbour. You may take a walk in Datca Harbour. We will cruise to Cnidus for dinner and an overnight stay. Knidos was the home for Aphrodite's monument and in those times the city was famous for brothels and became popular for sailors and Arabic tradesmen. You may take a walk on the shore to see the ruins.

Day 7: BLACK ISLAND – (POYRAZ BAY – METEOR BAY) - BODRUM



BODRUM

Bodrum has a history that goes back to the 12th century B.C. The city was called 'Halicarnassus' and it was the birthplace of Herodotus; the 'Father of History' who lived in the 5th century B.C. The 'Mausoleum' of King Mausolus (350 B.C.) one of the Seven Wonders of the World is in this city. The only structure that survived from the Classical Era is the Amphitheatre. It is one of the oldest theatres in Anatolia with a capacity of 13.000 guests and it is still hosting many shows and concerts for the art-lovers of Bodrum. Another place that you should visit when you arrive in Bodrum is the landmark of the city, the 'Castle of Saint Peter'. It is one of the best preserved pieces of architecture with a history dating back to the Medieval Ages. 'Myndos Gate' through which Alexander the Great entered Halicarnassus is another place that you should not miss to visit.

BENCIK

Bencik is located at the narrowest part of the peninsula that divides the Hisaronu Gulf from the Gokova Gulf but it is located on Hisaronu side. In 550s B.C. the Cnidus people wanted to dig a tunnel in the narrowest land piece of the peninsula between the Hisaronu Gulf and the Gokova Gulf as a defence line against the Persians. In that way, they would make two peninsulas one island and the defence would be easier. They started with diligence and put in a lot of effort; however, in the end they could not manage and the city was conquered by the Persians.

BOZBURUN

Although quieter than Marmaris bay's two centers of tourism of international renowned (Marmaris and İçmeler), Bozburun is a precious discovery for visitors due to its natural beauties and the exceptional flora. Its thyme honey is famous across Turkey. It has a small yet lovely harbor is also one of the key stops on the popular nautical tourism route of Blue Cruise. Its pristine sea is surrounded by coves.

CLEOPATRA (SEDIR) ISLAND

This unique island with its small beach and unbelievable clear water is like an open-air museum. You can see the city walls, the temple from the time of Dorians' reign (later restored as a church), the amphitheatre with 1.500 guest capacity and some vaulted historical buildings. You can walk around the wrecks of pillars with antique writings on them or the ancient stones decorated with reliefs. Cleopatra Beach, located on this island, has a very special kind of sand that can only be found in the deserts of Northern Africa. According to the myth, King Antonius brought the sand from Egypt via sea for Cleopatra.

DATCA

Datca was founded by the Dorians who came from Aegean Sea to the southern coast of Ionia in the 7th century B.C. The island has no humidity at all and has fresh air with plenty of oxygen. The historian Strabon was right when he remarked of Datca's weather: "God would send his beloved servants to Datca to live longer". According to a myth, while the Spanish pirates were passing by the coast of Datca, they disembarked people with Hansen's disease in Sarıliman Bay and these abandoned people recovered from their disease with the help of the clean weather of Datca.

Datca Peninsula is a prized location for tourists visiting Turkey, especially by sea, because of the beauty of its many coves and larger bays, which are favoured ports of call for those undertaking the celebrated Blue Cruise along Turkey's spectacular southwest coast.

FETHIYE

Fethiye, which was known as Telmessos in the ancient times, was the most important city situated on Lycia's western border with Caria. It is believed that the city's name comes from Apollon's son Telmessos. As the name suggests, the city was the city of light and was famous for its prophets. Fethiye stretches in a half circle along the bay protected by 12 Islands.



GOCEK

Set at the deepest point of the gulf of Fethiye, Gocek nestles at the foot of the pine clad mountains looking out over the '12 islands' of the bay. Gocek which has recently started developing in tourism, is becoming a famous yachting harbour both in Turkey and in the world. One of the pleasures of a visit here is a stroll around the Marina to admire the array of boats of all shapes and sizes moored here. The waterfront is lined with bars and restaurants. With Dalaman Airport is only 30 minutes away, Gocek makes an ideal base while waiting for guests or visitors.

The Bay of Skopea, which streches out from the village, is a perfect place for cruising; its twelve islands offer abundance of sheltered coves. Tersane Island features the partially submerged ruins of a Byzantine monestry and an ancient boat-yard. There is a restaurant on the island, making it a favourite overnight anchorage. Thought this area is called the 12 islands, there are, in fact, far more than that and you could easily explore a different one each day of your holiday.

KNIDOS (CNIDUS)

Cnidus was a developed city in science, art and architecture. Eudoxos, a very popular astronomer and maths professor; Dr. Euryphon; Polygontos, a popular painter; Skopas and Bryaksis of Faros, the most famous sculptors of the era; Sostrates, the architect of Alexandrian light house -one of the seven wonders of the World- and Ktesias the doctor, who saved the life of a Persian king from a disaster, lived on this island. Dr. Euryphon and his students founded the second biggest medical science school in Cnidus. The island also hosts the largest sun clock of its time which was erected by Eudoksos. Cnidus was the home for Aphrodite's monument and in those times the city was famous for brothels and became popular for sailors and Arabic tradesmen. You may also take a walk on the shore to see the ruins.



MARMARIS

Marmaris, which was built upon one of the antique Karian cities called Phyckos, has been under the rule of many different civilizations. The most valuable work of art that you can see today is Marmaris Castle dating from 1577. There is also a mosque and an 8-room caravansary covered with arches from the Ottoman Period. The ruins of the Antique times lie on Asar Hill; a small, low hill located on the northern side of the city. Being one of the best-known touristic places of Turkey, Marmaris has also a large marina and night life.

OLUDENIZ

Oludeniz (official translation name Blue Lagoon, literally Dead Sea; because of being calm even during storms) is a small resort village in the Fethiye district which is in the Muğla Province the Southwest coast of Turkey on the Aegean Sea to the south and the high, steep sided Babadağ Mountain, 14 km south of Fethiye. The town is a beach resort. Oludeniz remains one of the most photographed beaches on the Mediterranean It has a secluded sandy bay at the mouth of Oludeniz, on a blue lagoon. The beach itself is a pebble beach. The lagoon is a national nature reserve and building is strictly prohibited. Oludeniz is famous for its shades of turquoise and aquamarine, and is an official blue flag beach, and is frequently rated among the top 5 beaches in the world by travellers and tourism journals alike.



IOS

los is a hilly island with cliffs and beautiful beaches. los was the setting for movies such as "Ginger and Cinnamon (Dillo con Parole mie)" or "Big Blue" partly shot at Manganari, one of the most beautiful beaches in Greece. The bustling city of los is located at Ormos Harbor in the Northwest and forms there a steep road to Chora, a very picturesque Cycladic village only accessible to pedestrians. los is famous with its night life.

KALYMNOS

Pothia Harbour is the capital of the island. The islanders ensured their livelihood with sponge diving for centuries. There are nice beaches such as Massouri, Mirties and Vlyhadia around the island.

KOS

Kos, known to be the birth place of Hippocrates, who is 'the Father of Medical Sciences', also Asclepion, the best known health center in antiquity is located here. All the people from the east Mediterranean with health problems were treated in Kos. Kos; the second largest island of the 12 islands (the Dodecanese Islands) has a very mild climate and very fertile lands. The island houses a 560-year-old tree, a 211-year-old fountain and a 290 km long beach. You may take a quick swim in Lambi Beach which is very close to Kos Harbour. Kos is one of the islands with the best night life. Nafklirou, a street full of bars, is always crowded, colourful, and full of life.

LEROS

Leros is a mountainous, green island with high cliffs and many small bays and villages. You should visit Platanos the main city of Leros with steep stairs, narrow streets, and flower gardens. From Platanos you can take the steps leading up the Castle of Leros climbing 300 steps. Rent a bike or explore this island on foot.

LIPSI

On Lipsi Island there are beautiful sandy beaches and crystal green waters. The capital with its white houses, numerous taverns, cafeterias and restaurants is located in the small natural port. On the island, the Church of the Catopanaghia constructed in the 7th century deserves a visit, along with the Church of Panopanaghia from the 15th century.

MYKONOS


Without any question Mykonos is one of the most famous and picturesque Islands in the Mediterranean and a jet set spot, known for its night life, whitewashed landscapes and beautiful sandy beaches. A walking tour of Hora must include visits to the windmills, to the Paraportiani Church, the Maritime and Cycladic museums and stops at designers' shops and Little Venice cafes. Make sure you meet "Petros" the Pelican, the mascot of Mykonos.

NAXOS

The island of Naxos is the largest and most central island in the Cyclades. Approaching the island by boat, you can see two small islands to the left and right of the harbour, one with the little church of Myrtidiotissa, and the other called Palatia which is linked to Naxos Town. The imposing gate, Portara is an ancient marble temple dedicated to Apollo. Ligdamis ordered this to be built in the God's honour in the 6th century B.C.

NISYROS

The volcano on Nisyros Island erupted in 1422 and is still active. Nikea village is located on the side of the crater is constituted with white streets and a mosaic-style square. You can still see the gases coming from the underground of the crater (volcano).



PAROS

Paros is located in the central Aegean Sea. It became known for its fine white marble. A must see is the bay Naoussa a natural harbor, closed by a chain or boom in the ancient times. The three villages of Dragoulas, Marmara and Tsipidos, situated in an open plain on the eastern side of the island occupy the site of an ancient town. They are known together as the "villages of Kephalos" after the steep and lofty hill of Kephalos. On this hilltop stands the abandoned monastery of Agios Antonios (St. Anthony).

PATMOS

Patmos is a small volcanic island in the Aegean Sea. It is at the coast of Asia Minor, to the south of Samos and west of Miletus. The island of Patmos is famous in history as the place of St. John's exile: "I John..... was in the island which is called Patmos, for the word of God and for the testimony of Jesus" (Revelation 1:9); there according to general belief the Beloved Disciple wrote the Apocalypse, the imagery of which was part inspired by the scenery of the island. The spot where St. John was favored with his revelations is pointed out as a cave on the slope of the hill, half way between the shore and the modern town of Patmos.

RHODES

Rhodes is the largest of the Dodecanese Islands. The island is quite a popular holiday destination as it has one of the best-preserved and the largest European Medieval cities and has warm weather for 300 days of the year. Rhodes has been the cradle of many civilizations; starting with the knights of St. John in the Middle Ages, then Ottomans and Italians. Thus, the island has a unique historical harmony and beauty. The main port of Rhodes is Rhodes City which bears the same name as the island. The other very touristic areas of Rhodes island are; Lindos and Kamiros. This city, which is still surrounded by a 12 meter thick city-wall which gives you the feeling of travelling back to Medieval times especially when you walk around its narrow, stone-paved roads. After dinner, we highly recommend you to enjoy in Rhodes Town night out.



SANTORINI

Santorini is today what remained after an enormous volcanic explosion which occurred some 3600 years ago at the height of the Minoan civilization destroying the earliest settlements on what was formerly a single island and leading to the creation of the current geological Caldera. Its spectacular physical beauty, along with a dynamic nightlife, has made the island one of Europe's tourist hotspots. A giant central lagoon surrounded by high steep cliffs on three sides. The capital Fira, as well as Imerovigli and Oia –a must see- cling to the top of the cliff looking down on the lagoon.

SYMI

Symi is a mountainous Greek Island once known for shipbuilding and sponge industries to the point that the population reached 22500. Today Symi's main industry is the tourism and the population has declined to 2500. Its interior is dotted with small valleys and its coastline alternates between rocky cliffs, beaches and isolated coves. Its main town located in the Northeast coast, is also named Symi and consists of the lower town around the harbor, typically referred to as "Yialos" and the upper town called "Hora". Panormitis is the island's famous monastery which is visited by people from all over the world, and many Greeks pay homage to St. Michael of Panormitis each year.

Our Yachts

We can provide gulets to accommodate groups from 2 cabins to 16 cabins which means our largest gulet can accommodate up to 36 guests. Each gulet has a mix of twin and double- bedded cabins. Each cabin has its own separate lavatory, shower and wash basin.

All our boats are wooden motor/sailor yachts which range from 15-45 meters in length. They are constructed in a traditional design and known in Turkish as gulets. We have divided our yachts into four qualities; Ultra Luxury Gulets, Luxury Gulets, Standard Plus Gulets (with A/C) and Standard Gulets (without A/C).

Our yachts offer a high standard of safety and comply with local government and international regulations. These regulations are monitored thoroughly by the coastguard and harbor masters.

Life on Board

On our exclusive tailor-made tours your yacht will anchor in 2 or 3 bays daily depending on your chosen itinerary and there will be a maximum of 4 hours cruising per day. The last stop will be the place where we will stay for the night. We will usually use the motor to power the gulet. However, from time to time if the wind/ weather conditions permit, your crew will be happy to use the sails as well.

All of our gulets are equipped with a dingy, which is fitted with an outboard engine. For our customers' use there is fishing and snorkeling equipment. Some of our gulets also have windsurf, canoe, water sports equipment and jet ski. Water sports and jet-skiing is at an extra cost and can be paid for on board. There are also ample opportunities to sample different water sports such as jet-skiing, waterskiing, ringo and banana boat riding. These are also available at an extra cost and are organized by specialist water sports groups at the different bays visited.

Once the gulet is moored you will have free time to visit any archaeological ruins, take a little walk in to the pine forests and generally explore the beautiful coastline. Reading your book and having a siesta under the shade with a breeze may be another option. Of course, sea-lovers can enjoy swimming, snorkeling and sunbathing. We can also organize private land excursions upon your request to the nearby local towns, ancient sites and natural attractions.

Food & Drinks on Board

The meals during the cruise are prepared on board and are of a high standard. We may also recommend some local fish restaurants on your route for you to sample on a few occasions if you would like to.

Menus will be decided before the trip according to your requests and preferences. We find our guests mainly prefer a traditional Turkish breakfast which consists of jams, honey, butter and fresh bread, a selection of cheeses, green olives, black olives, eggs, tomato and cucumber.







This is served with strong Turkish tea, coffee, juice or milk. The chefs on board may prepare a surprise for our guests every morning such as scrambled egg with traditional Turkish sucuk (spicy sausage) or a selection of traditional Turkish pastries.

Lunch is usually a light meal, which most of our guests prefer in the heat of the day.

One main course, which is most delicious, is a Turkish vegetable meal (sometimes stuffed with meat) accompanied by salads, pasta, rice or chips and followed by fruit. Afternoon tea time consists of tea, coffee, kinds of cookies and sometimes pastries.



At dinner the main course is fish or meat accompanied by kinds of Turkish and Greek mezes (starters) followed by desserts and fruit.

If you have any special requests (religious preferences - health oriented) these can be organized if notice is given beforehand.

Full Board supplement for a luxury menu is \odot 25,-and a deluxe menu is \odot 35,-per person per day.

The Deluxe menu is rich in sea food and consists of four servings a week of fresh local fish, calamari, octopus and shrimp. The Luxury Menu has three servings of fresh local fish and other sea food.

All inclusive supplement for unlimited local alcoholic drinks, beverages and bottled water is $\hbox{\ensuremath{\Bbb{C}}}$ 25,-per person per day.

Child discount for food and drinks will be applied as free for 0-5 years and 6-12 years is 50% of the adult fare.

There is always the possibility of buying and storing your food supply yourself and our staff will be more than happy to set you guidelines for all you would need for a week's holiday.

The beverages are available at the bar on board of every yacht at a reasonable price; however you may also stock your own beverages before your departure.

In either case the services will be provided by the crew and this service is included in the price.

If you would like to stay alone in a double cabin, you will need to pay an extra 60% as a single supplement

General Procedures for "Cabin Charters"

1. Check in and boarding starts from 15:30 on your first day and the first meal is dinner on board. Checkout will be on the last day after breakfast at 10:30 am

As the first and the last days are transfer days, these nights will be spent in the marina.

3. During the "Blue Cruise" the engines will mostly be used. However the sails can be opened from time to time according to the weather conditions and wind direction. The sail on the yacht will be opened at least twice a week.

4. The captain may make changes to the cruise programme according to the sea and weather conditions. This is for the safety and security of our guests. Sailing is not permitted by port authorities in case of winds if 6-7 Beaufort or more.

5. It is not allowed to bring drinks or alcoholic beverages on board from outside. A large selection of drinks can be purchased from the bar of the yacht at a reasonable price and bills will be paid at the end of the cruise.

6. Our cruises are sold directly as well as through our tour operators. Our clients consist of people who love the sea from all over the globe and we believe this creates the perfect opportunity to meet people from every type of culture. We cannot and do not control the age or nationality of guests on board. No children under the age of 12 are allowed on board for Cabin Charters. For those who have children, they may hire a private gulet as we have gulets that are ranged from 2 cabins and more. If you would like to hire a Private Yacht then please see our Private Yacht Charter section.

7. Our cruises are carefully planned and every detail thoughtfully considered. We have had the experience of planning cruises for a number of years. Tours are printed in our brochures and therefore we cannot make changes to the itinerary according to customer's special requirements.

8. Instructions of the boat will be given to our guests by the embarkation.

We cannot give any guarantee for twin or triple cabins on the programmes numbered 1 to 4 with standard yachts.

10. All cabins have private WC / shower, portholes and a small wardrobe. The toilets can either be flushing type, marine type toilet with a pump or electrical.

11. In all of our boat there is sufficient safety equipment on board including life jackets & lines, dingy boats and a life raft. These all meet international safety requirements.

12. For the programs 1 to 4 with standard yachts we guarantee an inverter or generator to charge your electrical gadgets in the communal areas. Though for the programmes 5 to 8 you may have 220V in your cabins too.

13. All yachts store basic fishing lines, flippers and snorkels for the use of our guests.

14. In our Cabin Charter prices, Port Charges for all ports and fuel surcharges are included in the price unlike other firms.

Private Charters (Exclusive Tailor - Made Tours)

Barbaros Yachting has wooden traditional gulets in 4 different classes

If you would like to rent a private yacht we will need to discuss the different options available to you depending on the size of your group. We will then find the best available gulet to suit your needs.

When you have decided on the gulet that you would like to hire, we will contact each other about the details such as itinerary, menu options and airport transfers.

We will send you a Charter Contract after finalizing the details.

PETS:

In our boats bringing pets are not permitted on board for several reasons. Crew is required to maintain rigid cleanliness standards for all their guests and there is a potential of allergens from animals remaining on board.

SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted to any of our passengers or members of the crew in any indoor part of the boat.

TIPPING

A crew gratuity is both customary and discretionary. 5% of the base charter fee is usually the norm depending totally on your discretion. It is usually given to the captain at the end of the charter and divided equally among the crew members. You do not have to give a tip, it depends on you.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

Participants must be in possession of a valid passport (expiring not earlier than one month after the cruise ends) and should obtain visas and health certificates where required. All requirements should be confirmed with appropriate government consulate or information office prior to departure. It is passenger's responsibility to obtain any visas, passports, health certificates or other travel documentation required.

LUGGAGE AND CLOTHING

Please travel as lightly as possible so as not to restrict any space in your cabin. Soft bags are more practical than hard suitcases. Sports or casual clothes are more useful. Plenty of swimwear is required and a pullover or cardigan is recommended for cool evenings. Comfortable walking shoes are suggested when ashore.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Due to safety reasons it is requested that physical disabilities of any kind be advised at time of reservation. It is understood that passengers require special attention or treatment will be travelling with their escorts. The company retains the right to refuse to embark any pregnant woman beyond the 6th month of pregnancy.

SPECIAL DIETARY REQUIREMENTS

Every attempt to meet special dietary requirements will be made provided that such a request is put in writing at least 2 weeks prior to sailing.

PASSENGERS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

Our boats are not suitable for passengers with special needs. Embarkation gang ways do not fit all types of wheel chairs. Cabin bathrooms and stair cases are unsuitable for disabled passengers.

LAND TOURS - OPTIONAL EXCURSIONS

Land tours are not included in the cruise fares and available according to the cruise schedule. Details are available on the written itineraries. Land tours are subject to shore and weather conditions and based on a minimum participation.

BOOKING

Cabin Charter (Cruises from the Brochure)

Deposit and Payment

To secure your reservation, a deposit of 25 % of the charter fee per person is required within seven (7) days of booking. Final payment is required 60 days prior to departure. All payments may be made by Visa, Master Card, or American Express or by money transfer. All reservations are subject to cancellation if payments are not received by the due date.

Cancellations and Refunds

For full refund of charter fee, notice of cancellation must be in writing and received by Barbaros Yachting no later than 60 days prior to sailing.

If a cancellation occurs, the following charges will apply:

- *60-31 days prior to departure: 25% of cruise fare
- *30-16 days prior to departure: 50% of cruise fare
- *15 days or less prior to departure: No refund

Refunds will normally be made to the booking party. Barbaros Yachting can only be responsible for refunding amounts actually received. No refunds will be made to passengers who do not board the boat or passengers who cancel after the start of the cruise. We recommend the purchase of travel insurance.

Private Yacht Charters (Exclusive Tailor-Made Gulet Tours)

Deposit and Payment

To confirm the reservation, 50% of the total charter price is needed, this will act as a deposit and the balance can be paid in cash when you embark.

This will be paid to our Barbaros Yachting Official who will be present when you embark the boat.

Cancellations and Refunds

For full refund of charter fee, notice of cancellation must be in writing and received by Barbaros Yachting no later than ninety (90) days prior to sailing.

If a cancellation occurs, the following charges will apply:

- * 90 days prior to your departure: 15% of the deposit will be funded as an administration fee; the rest of the deposit will be refunded.
- * Less than 89-60 days prior to departure: 35% of the deposit will be funded as an administration fee; the rest of the deposit will be refunded.
- *Less than 59 days prior to your departure, the deposit will not be refunded.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Boat Substitution

Barbaros Yachting may operate the cruise program with another boat as long as this boat is of the same or higher standard. Passengers offered a suitable alternative cruise program or boat are not entitled to any refund.

Cruise Interruption

Barbaros Yachting may for any reason whatsoever cancel any cruise at any time for reasons of force majeure.

During the cruise should the boat sustain any breakdown in machinery, or be disabled by fire, grounding or collision disrupting the cruise itinerary for more than 48 hours, and if no substitute boat or arrangement is offered, passengers will be entitled to a refund proportional to the cruise days not operated. No further claims will be accepted.

It is further recognized that Barbaros Yachting is a Turkish Company, and it is agreed between Barbaros Yachting and contractual party that the interpretation of the terms and conditions will be resolved solely according to the Turkish Laws in Turkish Courts.

Responsibilities

Barbaros Yachting is responsible for making all the arrangements for everything specified in the services and itineraries. Barbaros Yachting liability and responsibility does not extend beyond the boat; any arrangements made by or for passengers either before boarding or when disembarking are at the passenger's own risk. Barbaros Yachting does not own or control any ground transportation or hotels. As a convenience to our passengers, Barbaros Yachting may sell tickets for land excursions or arrange other services which are operated by independent contractors, but shall not be responsible in any way whatsoever for any damage, loss, injury or death arising.

Nevertheless, all of the service provided in the boat bears Barbaros Yachting guarantee and responsibility for quality service, which we provide to all of our customers with.

All travel documents issued by Barbaros Yachting, in written paraphernalia or to the customer, are subject to the terms and conditions specified by the laws of Turkey.

Barbaros Yachting preserves the right to cancel the whole tour without a refund, once the capacity of the passengers excess the booking and the capacity of the boat itself.

Insurance:

All boats are under fully comprehensive and third party insurances. The insurance covers even the medical expenses in case of injury onboard during the cruise and the cost of personal belongings in case of accidents that may occur while at sea. However, the insurance does not cover the accidents or injuries etc. that may occur beyond the boat, thus we do advise you to have your own personal travel, health, accident, cancellation, luggage and trip-interruption insurance.

Force Majeure:
